ARCHERY CLUB BEHAVIOUR POLICY:

By signing this agreement the Archer agrees to follow the policies outlined below. Failure to follow these rules will be cause for expulsion from the Club.

- THERE WILL BE NO HORSEPLAY PERMITTED
- I will be responsible for my own behaviour.
- I will help with cleaning of the facility at the end of each day.
- I will be responsible for my own equipment and personal belongings.
- I will not draw a bow back without an arrow on the string (risk of dry-fire).

- I will not handle another archer's equipment without permission directly from them. I will obey all safety rules.
- I will listen to and follow the direction(s) of the coaches.
- I will not bring or use alcohol or illegal substances.
- I will not bring any other weapons to the Club.
- I will follow a "hands off" policy (no touching, hitting or fighting).
- I will respect coaches and other members.

CLUB EQUIPMENT:

The club has some equipment for use by members. We have right and left hand recurve and compound bows, as well as some arrows. Please remember these items must be shared by all new members who do not have their own equipment.

NOTES:

- Annual individual/family membership is payable by cheque or money order to Glooscap Heritage Archers Association. Membership runs from January 1st – December 31st annually. New memberships are accepted throughout the year.
- Each individual shooter must sign-in on entering the facility. All archers wanting to shoot at Glooscap Heritage Archers Association must have an AC/ANNS membership card in their possession.
- Glooscap Heritage Archers Association hosts at least two shoots annually. Up-to-date shoot schedule is available at www.aans.ca
- Membership meetings are held on the 2nd Sunday of each month at 6:30 p.m. All members are invited and encouraged to attend as your input is important.

NEW MEMBERSHIP:

New members are welcome to join the Glooscap Heritage Archers Association. To shoot at the club you must attend an orientation session, where you will be given shooting instructions and safety information. The first three (3) nights will be free and you must pass the basic instruction and be certified by one of our coaches to attend our regular shoots on Sunday and Wednesday nights. After three (3) weeks you must become a member of the Club and AANS to be able to continue shooting at the club.

There is a probationary period for new members before disbursement of keys and/or door code is provided, with a minimum 10 visits within a 3 month period to be entitled to full access of the facilities. Requests for access (key and/or door code) shall be submitted in writing for consideration before the Executive. Upon approval, the member(s) will be responsible for costs incurred for a reproduction of a gate key and will be entrusted with the door code.
